All activities will be led by an instructor who has the relevant experience, awards or qualifications and they will maintain a high level of safety throughout the session, however, injuries are still possible through contact with the holds and the climbing wall surface. We do not consider the wearing of helmets necessary during childrens sessions. Please read our Helmet policy for more information. All participants must adhere to all instructions given by staff. Thank you.
